Holy Habit number 2! Gladness and Generosity

Following the success of our first Holy Habit, **Eating Together**, through which we shared food, fellowship and fun together, we move on through November and December to explore the theme of **Gladness and Generosity**.

The timing is perfect as we prepare for Christmas, the season of goodwill to all people. The church was born in **Gladness** for what God has done for each one of us through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. In the early church there was much **Gladness** in believers' homes, in the temple and out on the streets. St. Luke notes in the book of Acts that they had glad and generous hearts, they embodied the generosity of the heart of God and were counter cultural in a world of avarice and greed. We too are called to live this way, being generous with all we have.
